

Visitor Guidelines

Daily Visiting Hours 8am-8pm

After 5pm weekdays/Saturday/Sunday visitors are required to check-in at the **Emergency Room Registration and/or Security Office**



Please Sanitize Hands upon entry

Keep a safe distance from others– social distancing 6 feet

Please DO NOT visit if you have COVID or COVID symptoms

Please WEAR A MASK over your nose & mouth if you:

- **Have suspected or confirmed SARS-CoV-2 infection or other respiratory infection**
- **Had close contact with anyone with COVID in the last 10 days**
- **Are visiting someone who is moderately to severely immunocompromised**

Emergency Room	Adult & Pediatric Patients: 2 visitors (Certain circumstances may allow for more than 2 visitors as deemed by RN/Provider) If Covid positive: Virtual or Scheduled Visitation Only. See Exceptions	<p>*End-of-Life: Visitation restrictions for covid positive patients will be at the discretion of the care team.</p> <p>*Caretakers: Visitors acting in the role of a care-taker will be allowed access as determined by the clinical team</p> <p>Please coordinate with Nursing Unit</p>
Labor and Delivery (Birthing Center)	Adult/Pediatric Inpatients: If Covid negative: No visitor restrictions If Covid positive—1 Support person only (same person)	
Inpatient Units	Adult/Pediatric Inpatients: If Covid Negative: No Visitor Restrictions If Covid positive: Virtual Or Scheduled Visitation Only. See Exceptions & Contact Nursing Unit	
The Center for Rehab and Wellness Service	Adult patients & Pediatric patients: No visitor Restrictions	
Urgent Care	No Visitor Restrictions	
Ambulatory Surgery Center	Adult patients: 1 designated visitor Pediatric patients: 2 parents/guardians	
Physician Offices/Practices	No visitor Restrictions	
Cath Lab/Diagnostic Imaging	Adult patients: No visitor restrictions	
Cancer Center/OP Infusion	Adult Patients: 2 Visitor limit please
